

VATC Awarded AFSOC SETA IV Subcontract

Tampa, Florida. Visual Awareness Technologies and Consulting, Inc. (VATC) has received an IDIQ award under the Air Force Special Operations Command (AFSOC) Systems Engineering & Technical Assistance (SETA IV) contract as part of a team led by B3H Corporation. The SETA IV contract award includes one base year with four option year periods for a potential five-year contract term with a \$85 million ceiling.

The SETA IV contract vehicle enables VATC to provide various A&AS and Non-A&AS support to HQ AFSOC directorates and other Special Operations Forces (SOF) activities. These services and support include program management for Advanced Technology Exploration and Demonstration planning, security, funding, test and transition; assist in management of AFSOC's participation in all experiments/ exercises; provide support of Command and Control (C2) systems as well as other Air Force Special Operations Forces (AFSOF) mission-related computer interests; provide analysis, research, training development, instruction, and management support to implement and sustain the required elements of the AFSOC tactics program; perform a wide-range of research, analysis, and administrative activities in support of the Air Force SOF-related mission to include monitoring exercises and manning Operations Center; research and analyses, design/development, fielding and evaluation of AFSOC tactics and training systems in support of AFSOC's current and emerging missions and weapon systems; and provide Current Operations and Training support in order to focus active duty aircrew members on directly supporting the 1 SOW contingency combat flying mission

All HQ AFSOC directorates are considered primary using activities for this contract effort; however, other organizations and agencies assigned to directly support, or be supported by, HQ AFSOC may receive similar A&AS or Non-A&AS services on an "as needed" basis.
